HOW YOUR DEBIT CARD WORKS IS CHANGING

An overdraft occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction. We may pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. AAEC Overdraft Protection, which is linked to your savings account.
- 2. AAEC Overdraft Coverage Soon we can no longer provide this coverage automatically for ATM & many Debit Card transactions if you want to keep it, you need to tell us.

This notice explains AAEC Overdraft Coverage.

What is the Overdraft Coverage that comes with my account?

We authorize and pay overdrafts, at our discretion, for the following types of transactions:

- · Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

Effective 8/15/10, AAEC Overdraft Coverage will continue for checks & automatic bill payments; however, we may not authorize and pay the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM transactions
- · Everyday debit card transactions

When you don't have enough money to make purchases or to pay for something unexpected, AAEC Overdraft Coverage may allow your transactions to be authorized, at our discretion.

Normally, deposits you make into your checking account may not be available for your use immediately, so you cannot start using those dollars right away. AAEC Overdraft Coverage may provide options when you need them.

If we do not authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction may be declined.

What fees will I be charged if AAEC Credit Union pays my overdraft?

Under our AAEC overdraft coverage:

- We will charge you a fee of \$25 each time we pay an overdraft.
- Also, if your account is overdrawn more than 1 day, we will charge an additional \$5 each day that your
 account remains overdrawn.
- There is no limit on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing.
- No fee to enroll and no fee if you never use it.

In this Agreement the words "we", "us", or the "Credit Union" refer to the credit union named abover, the words "you" and "you" refer to the member/customer (and joint account holder, if any), the words "cuCheck CardicuCash Card" refer to the Services Credit Union usCheck Card/ATM access card or cuCash ATM access card. Card and PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (PIN) By using your CuCheck CardiouCash Card, you agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement and accompanying Disclosure Statement.

1. cuCheck Card/cuCash Card: The cuCheck Card/cuCash Card is the property of Services Credit Union and is subject to revocation at any time. It must be returned to us by you upon request. You agree that the CuCheck Card/cuCash Card issued to you

CONFIDENTIALITY

We will disclose information to third parties about your account or the transfers you make:

(1) where it is necessary for completing transfers; or
(2) in order to verify the existence and condition of your account for a third party, such as a credit bureau or merchant; or

(3) In order to comply with government agency or court orders; or

(4) if you give us written permission.

UNAUTHORIZED TRANSFERS

(a) Consumer liability. Tell us AT ONCE II you believe your card and/or code has been lost or stolen, or if you believe that an electronic fund transfer has been made without your permission using information from your check or draft. Telephoning is the best way of keeping your possible losses down. You could lose all the money in your account (plus your maximum overdraft line of credit). If you tell us within 2 business days after you learn of the loss or theft of your card and/or code, you can lose no more than \$50 if someone used your card and/or code without your permission.

If you do NOT tell us within 2 business days after you learn of the loss or theft of your card and/or code, and we can prove we could have stopped someone from using your card and/or code without your permission if you had told us, you could lose as much as \$500.

as much as 5500.

Also, if your statement shows transfers that you did not make, including those made by card, code or other means, tell us at once. If you do not tell us within 60 days after the statement was mailed to you, you may not get back any money you lost after the 60 days if we can prove that we could have stopped someone from taking the money if you had told us in time.

If a good reason (such as a long trip or a hospital stay) kept a from telling us, we will extend the time periods.

(b) Contact in event of unauthorized transfer. If you believe your card and/or code has been lost or stolen, call or write us at the telephone number or address listed in this brochure. You should also call the number or write to the address listed in this brochure if you believe a transfer has been made using the information from your check or draft without your permission. A police report is required.

ERROR RESOLUTION NOTICE

In Case of Errors or Questions About Your Electronic Transfers, Call or Write us at the telephone number or address listed in this brochure, as soon as you can, if you think your statement or receipt is wrong or if you need more information about a transfer listed on the statement or receipt. We must hear from you no later than 60 days after we sent the FIRST statement on which the problem or error appearance.

- (1) Tell us your name and account number (if any).
- Describe the error or the transfer you are unsure about, and explain as clearly as you can why you believe it is an error or why you need more information.
 Tell us the dollar amount of the suspected error.

If you tell us orally, we may require that you send us your applaint or question in writing within 10 business days.

complaint or question in writing within 10 business days.

We will determine whether an error occurred within 10 business days (5 business days for cucheck Card point-of-sale transactions and 20 business days if the transfer involved a new account) after we hear from you and will correct any error promptly. If we need more time, however, we may take up to 45 days (90 days (11) the transfer involved a new account, a point-of-sale transaction, or a foreign-initiated transfer) to investigate your complaint or question. If we decide to do this, we will credit your account within 10 business days (5 business days for cuCheck Card point-of-sale transactions and 20 business days if the transfer involved a new account) for the amount you think is in error, so that you will have the use of the money during the time it takes us to complete our investigation. If we ask you to put your complaint or question in writing and we do not receive it within 10 business days, we may not credit your account. Your account is considered a new account for the first 30 days after the first deposit is made, unless each of you already has an established account with us before this account is opened.

We will tell you the results within three business days after completing our investigation. If we decide that there was no error, we will send you a written explanation.

You may ask for copies of the documents that we used in our investigation.

FACILITY USER PRECAUTIONS

As with all financial transactions, please exercise discretion when using an automated teller machine (ATM) or night deposit facility. For your own safety, be careful. The following suggestions may be helpful.

- stions may be helpful.

 Prepare for your transactions at home (for instance, by filling out a deposit slip) to minimize your time at the ATM or night deposit facility.

 Mark each transaction in your account record, but not while at the ATM or night deposit facility. Always save your ATM receipts. Don't leave them at the ATM or night deposit facility because they may contain important account information.
- Compare your records with the account statements you
- Don't lend your ATM card to anyone.
- Don't lend your ATM card to anyone.

 Remember, do not leave your card at the ATM. Do not leave any documents at a night deposit facility.

 Protect the secrecy of your Personal Identification Number (PIN). Protect your ATM card as though it were cash Don't tell anyone your PIN. Don't give anyone information regarding your ATM card or PIN over the telephone Never enter your PIN in any ATM that does not look genuine, has been modified, has a suspicious device atlached, or is operating in a suspicious manner. Don't write your PIN where it can be discovered For example, don't keep a note of your PIN in your wallet or purse.
- Prevent others from seeing you enter your PIN by using your body to shield their view.
- If you lose your ATM card or if it is stolen, promptly notify us. You should consult the other disclosures you have received about electronic fund transfers for additional information about what to do if your card is lost or stolen.
- lost or stolen. When you make a transaction, be aware of your surroundings. Look out for suspicious activity near the ATM or night deposit facility, particularly if it is after sunset. At night, be sure that the facility (including the parking area and walkways) is well lighted. Consider having someone accompany you when you use the facility, especially after sunset. If you observe any problem, go to another ATM or night deposit facility. Only accept assistance from anyone you idnot known.
- Don't accept assistance from anyone you don't know when using an ATM or night deposit facility.
- when using an Arm or night deposit facility. If you notice anything suspicious or if any other problem arises after you have begun an ATM transaction, you may want to cancel the transaction, pocket your card and leave. You might consider using another ATM or coming back later.

- Don't display your cash, pocket it as soon as the ATM transaction is completed and count the cash later when you are in the safety of your own car, home, or other secure surrounding.
- surrounding. At a drive-up facility, make sure all the car doors are locked and all of the windows are rolled up, except the driver's window. Keep the engine running and remain alert to your surroundings.

 We want the ATM and night deposit facility to be safe and convenient for you. Therefore, please tell us if you know of any problem with a facility. For instance, let us know if a light is not working or there is any damage to a facility. Please report any suspicious activity or crimes to both the operator of the facility and the local law enforcement officials immediately.

Receipts for EFT transactions (debit credit ATM card transactions) of \$15,00 or less are no longer mandatory. Most merchants and financial institutions will continue to provide them, however expect these receipts to be phased out as processing equipment is upgraded.
